

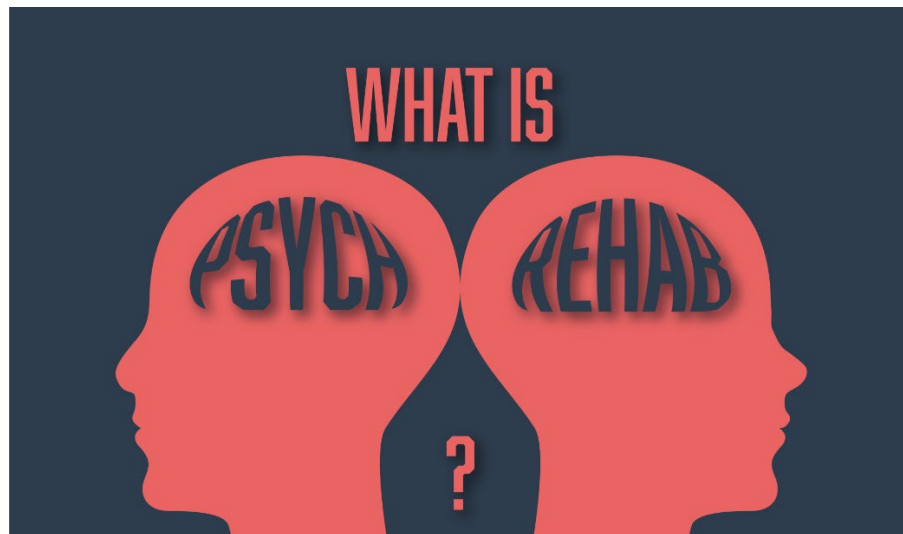

David serves as a consultant and trainer for the Dartmouth Hitchcock Medical Center to the New Hampshire Bureau of Mental Health Services; and he is a deputy program director for dissemination and implementation resources on the SAMHSA National Registry for Evidence Based Programs and Practices. David works with MG&A on the development and implementation of employment programs. David has worked with numerous federal and state projects including the Recovery After Initial Schizophrenia Episode (RAISE) program for the National Institute of Mental Health; the National Implementing Evidence Based Practices Project for the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration; the Johnson & Johnson – Dartmouth Supported Employment Program; the national Homeless Veteran's Supported Employment Program

(HVSEP); and the national implementation of Supported Employment services for the Veteran's Administration.

### **Tech Requirements**

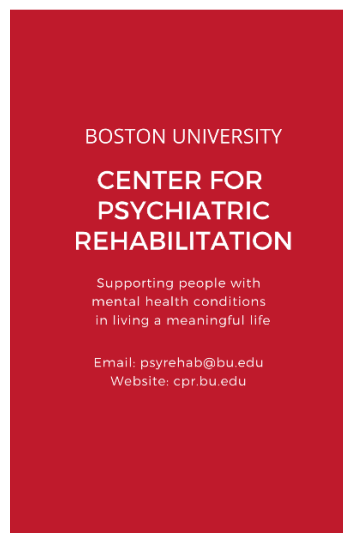
